It's now all systems go!

Amid the atmosphere of rejoicing within the universal Church following the recent election of Pope Leo XIV, the members of the St. Ezekiel Moreno Province turn their prayerful attention toward the Talavera House of Prayer in Cebu City where the much-anticipated 9th Provincial Chapter will begin on May 19, Monday.

The Province's Silver Legacy

This 9th Provincial Chapter marks a pivotal moment in the life of the Province, which has recently celebrated its silver founding jubilee (1998–2024). The milestone has rekindled reflection on the Province's mission and growth. As the Church, the Order, and the Province face evolving pastoral challenges, the Chapter offers a crucial opportunity for capitulars to evaluate present realities, discern new paths, and craft decisions that will responsibly shape the years ahead.

Though the future remains uncertain, the experience of the past 25 years—combined with the present moment—points to the Divine Providence at work with and through the brothers spread mainly in five countries/territories: the Philippines, Sierra Leone, Indonesia, Saipan, and Vietnam. The Chapter becomes not just a time for "special" governance, but also for spiritual renewal and recommitment to the mission entrusted to the Province and its constituents.

TWG Finalizes Preparations

On May 13, 2025, the day after the Philippine national and local elections, the seven-member Chapter Secretariat—also known as the Technical Working Group (TWG)—gathered at the Chapter venue to finalize the preparations. The team includes Frays Leander Barrot, Reynaldo Jaranilla, Robin Ross Plata, Julius James Tinapao, Chrislean Rey Pamilaga, and Ma'am Brenda Saliendra, a Sister-General of the Order. Fray Jose Ernil Almayo, the incumbent Provincial Secretary, leads the group.

Tasked with overseeing logistical and technical arrangements, the TWG is responsible for setting up the venue, securing necessary equipment and materials, and facilitating a "less paper" proceedings in line with the Province's sustainability efforts. Their encompasses the demands documentation: from recording, transcription, and translation to editing and layout design; from photography and videography to post-Chapter publication—ensuring a seamless documented event of the triennium.

TRIVIA: THE NUMERICAL SIDE VIEW (AND OTHER VIEWS) RELATED TO THE 9TH PROVINCIAL CHAPTER

No doubt, 2025 is such a historic year. A Jubilee year declared by the pope who died on the same year. And in which year another pope, "a son of St. Augustine" and the fourth in non-Italian succession, got elected to continue the Petrine ministry.

Although we are almost halfway through 2025, we, in the Province of St. Ezekiel Moreno, can still feel the breeze of the silver anniversary of our First Chapter held on Provincial November 1999. Which means, November 2024 marked not just the culmination of the 25th founding anniversary celebration of the Province but also the 25th anniversary of the Province's first provincial chapter which took place in Talavera House of Prayer (Cebu City).

As we bask in the overflowing blessings of these milestones, we would like to take a look at the preparations being made in view of the 9th Provincial Chapter which will start on Monday, May 19, also here in Talavera.

Here is a "side view," with some added views, on the numerical aspects of the said chapter.

Observations:

- This number of capitulars (i.e., 28) equals that of the 2022 chapter. This
 is an increase of one to the 27 total number of capitulars in 2018 touted
 then as "so far the highest number ... in all Provincial Chapters of St.
 Ezekiel Moreno Province."
- The capitulars' average age is 52.36, which is the highest among the previous chapters: 51.85 in the 2022 chapter, 50.33 in the 2018 chapter, and 49.00 in the 2015 chapter. Speaking of the Province's senescence and the reality of aging...
- Recoletos de Manila has the most number of attendance: four (4) friars.
- Following the streamlined guidelines for the election of the Prior Provincial, the (re)election of Fray Bernard Amparado even before the start of the chapter is unprecedented.

Frays Silloriquez and Caligdong are the oldest and the youngest, respectively, both in age and in simple profession. *If the traditional practice were*

to be followed, they (together with Fray Jamero, the lone Religious Brother) are destined to become tellers of the Chapter. 02

Six (6) or 21.4% had their theological formation in Marcilla (Spain); the rest (22, or 78.6%), at RFC/RST in Mira Nila.

More than half (16, or 57%) of the number of capitulars come from the Visayas.

The sequence (SEQ) from 1 to 28 is the basis for the capitulars' seating arrangement at the Chapter hall.

Observations



Of the 28 present capitulars:

- four (4) had attended the very first provincial chapter, in November 1999;
- nobody got a perfect attendance as a capitular in all nine (9) provincial chapters. The most number of chapters attended was seven (7), and only three (3) or 11 % of the current capitulars were then present.
- eight (8) or 29% are first-timers as capitulars.
- only one (1) is a non-Filipino the current Prior General who, for the second time, presides the provincial chapter. Although this is obvious since, from the start of our Province, the Prior General has always been a non-Filipino, we simply note that there were times when non-Filipinos representing our mission in Sierra Leone participated in a provincial chapter, to wit: Jose Luis Garayoa in 2009 and Joseph Shonibare in 2012.
